

O-CEI Approach for data and identity management

- O-CEI platform facilitates the realization of computing continuum systems and enables a trusted information exchange
- Leveraging advanced top-notch technologies to ensure data governance, traceability, confidentiality, and privacy
- Build trust and sovereignty by restricting access to authorized information and resources
- O-CEI Federated Marketplace will be aligned with key initiatives such as DOME, IDSA or Gaia-X








O-CEI Approach for data and identity management

- O-CEI will follow a zero-trust federated identity management schema, acting as a broker for secure and seamless resource access with users and systems having their own digital passports
- Agreements will be enforced through smart contracts, serving as the main source of trusted authorization
- Accountability and traceability will audit critical actions performed by users with a digital passport (IOTA, IOTA Tangle 2.0)



European Blockchain Services Infrastructure

- The European Blockchain Services Infrastructure (EBSI) is a **blockchain infrastructure** that offers **cross-border public services**
- A network of the European Blockchain Partnership Members **using the infrastructure** to cooperate via cross-border public services, connect existing solutions or integrate specific services
- Improve cross-border public services for citizens and businesses to strengthen collaboration between governments and public authorities, aligning with EU policies upholding the highest standards of sustainability, privacy, and security.
- CERTH operates one of the two EBSI nodes in Greece.
- The CERTH-ITI Wallet is conformant with version 3 of the EBSI conformance testing.
- The 4th version of the conformance testing is expected to be released on 1st of June 2025.




Notarisation of documents
